Kingspan Insulation Limited is a subsidiary of Kingspan Group plc and operates within the construction and manufacturing sector. This gender pay gap report is based on data as at 5th April 2021. At this date Kingspan Insulation limited employed 759 people with 603 being male and 156 female.

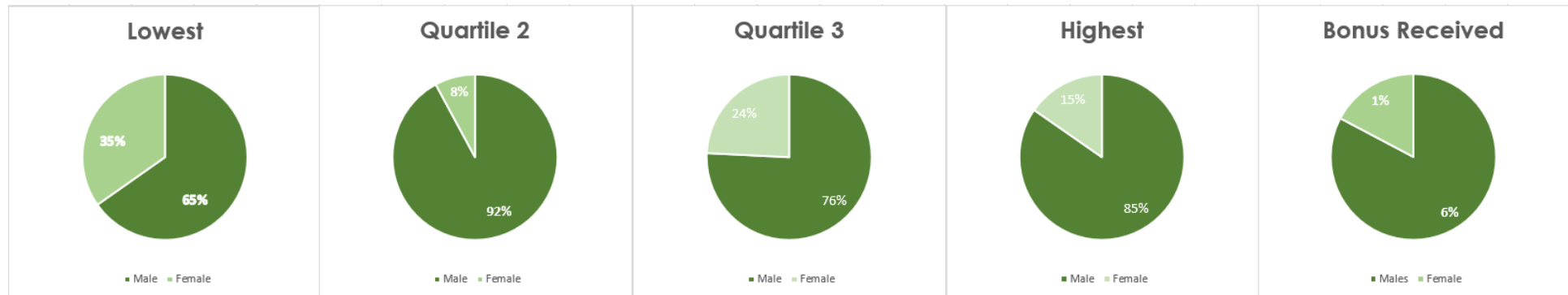
The gender pay gap measures the difference between men and women's average earnings and is shown as a percentage of men's pay.
